CODE OF CONDUCT

- I am expected to attend all sessions that are part of the planned program for all activities. I will inform staff if I am not feeling well.
- 2. I will be courteous clean, and possess good manners.
- 3. Language must be controlled no profanity.
- 4. I will not leave the activity facilities at any time without the permission of the chaperone and/or staff members.
- 5. I will not smoke or use tobacco products at the FFA workshop.
- 6. I will not use alcohol, drugs (except those directed by a doctor), or be associated with or remain in the presence of others when they are being used.
- I will not carry a weapon or threaten another person with a weapon, bodily force, or language.
- 8. I will respect the rights of privacy of those attending an activity and those with whom I am rooming.
- 9. I will observe hours established by the staff and be in my room. No boys in girls' room; no girls in boys' rooms.
